## GENERAL EVENT INFORMATION

### RULES & POLICIES

[DockDogs Rules & Policies](#) will be enforced at this event. By registering, you are implying that you have read, understand, and will abide by the [DockDogs Rules & Policies](#).

This is an OUTDOOR event to be run off of a SCAFFOLDING DOCK into a POOL. There will be **FOUR** competition docks & pools used at this event.

This event is a 5 x High Points Chase event – and will start the HPC race for the 2010 Season.

All dog / handler teams MUST check in on-site at least ONE hour prior to the start of their first scheduled Competition. If a team has not checked in one (1) hour prior, THEY WILL NOT COMPETE, NO EXCEPTIONS!

**NOTE: Early Bird Check In will be open from 7 – 10 pm on Thursday in hotel lobby.**

Pre-Registration is mandatory. There is no registration online or on site. Registration is by fax or by scan / email to [info@dockdogs.com](mailto:info@dockdogs.com).

Dog / handler teams will be placed in groups of up to 12 teams within each group. Each team will receive two (2) official jumps per competition.

Bitches in heat will NOT be allowed to compete or permitted in the venue area.

### ELIGIBILITY

To participate in the 2009 DockDogs National Championships, teams must have an active 2009 DockDogs Worldwide Membership.

- In order to participate in Big Air, a team must be TITLED in Big Air.
- In order to participate in Extreme Vertical, a team must be TITLED in Extreme Vertical.
- In order to participate in Speed Retrieve, a team must be TITLED in Speed Retrieve.
- In order to participate in Iron Dog, a team must be Nationally Ranked in all three disciplines (Big Air, Extreme Vertical, and Speed Retrieve).

**NOTE:** For teams that hold a National & Regional Title, the National Title prevails over the Regional Title, i.e. Senior National Title vs. Elite Regional Title – team will compete in the Senior Division.

### QUALIFYING ROUNDS

A Qualifying Round will be offered for the following divisions in each sport.

- Big Air: Novice, Junior, Senior, Master, Elite, Super Elite, Young Handler, Lap Dog, and Veteran Dog
- Speed Retrieve: Express, Turbo, Sonic
- Extreme Vertical: Cadet, Top Gun

Separate rounds of competition will take place for Iron Dog participants.

In addition to competing within a Titled Division, Big Air Teams may also choose to compete at one level higher. For example, a team with a Master title will be permitted to register for the Elite Qualifying Round as well. This option is not available for Extreme Vertical or Speed Retrieve.

## BONUS ROUNDS!

In addition to competing within a Titled Division, all teams are encouraged to compete in the BONUS rounds on Saturday. The purpose of the Bonus rounds are to give teams an opportunity to further improve their scores, but also will allow dogs with multiple handlers to appear with two handlers in the same division to compete for the highest qualifying score.

**NOTE:** All teams must compete in the Qualifying Round in order to also compete in the BONUS round. The only exception is when one dog has multiple handlers. For example, Suzie/Fido have a Senior Title and Bob/Fido have a Senior Title. They only have one dog in their household. Suzie/Fido can participate in the Senior Qualifying Round on Friday and Bob/Fido can participate in the Senior BONUS Round on Saturday. The team with the highest score would be considered a Finals Round.

Just as in the Qualifying Rounds, Big Air teams may choose to compete at one level higher in the Bonus Rounds as well.

***A single team could jump in 2 Qualifying Rounds & 2 BONUS rounds, for a total of 4waves at the 2009 Cabela's National DockDogs® Championships!***

## FINALS ROUNDS

The Top Eight (8) Big Air teams from the Qualifying and BONUS rounds collectively will compete in the associated Divisional Finals of Novice, Junior, Senior, Master, Elite, and Super Elite.

The Top Eight (8) Speed Retrieve teams from the Qualifying and BONUS rounds collectively will compete in the associated Divisional Finals of Express, Turbo, and Sonic.

The Top Four (4) Extreme Vertical teams from the Qualifying Round (Friday) and the Top Four (4) Extreme Vertical teams from the BONUS Round (Saturday) will compete in the Finals Rounds in their respective Extreme Vertical Finals of Cadet and Top Gun.

**NOTE:** *The reason for taking the top 4 EV teams from each day in each division rather than taking the top 8 teams overall is to prevent the scenario of having to break a tie between two days.*

The Iron Dog competition will take place as separate discipline competitions. There will not be an Iron Dog Final, but the Top 8 Iron Dog teams according to cumulative score will be recognized on Sunday during Finals Rounds.

## AWARDS

All Finals Rounds will be followed immediately with an Awards Presentation on the same dock that the competition took place. Handlers or a handler's representative must be present to accept ribbons and awards. Ribbons and awards will not be mailed.

Participant Awards can be picked up on site at the completion of the Qualifying or Bonus Rounds.

## LAP DOG, VETERAN, & YOUNG HANDLERS

In addition to the special finals, Lap Dog teams, Young Handler teams, and Veteran Dog teams may participate in Qualifying and Bonus rounds that they are eligible for in addition to their special rounds as well.

## EVENT & FESTIVITIES REGISTRATION

The Competition Registration Fees are payable to DockDogs through fax-in OR scan/email only as follows:

- \$25 / Qualifying Round; \$20 / BONUS Round
- \$50 for Iron Dog

**Cabela's National DockDogs® Championships Club Challenge**  
**2007 & 2008 Defending National Club Challenge Champions: Wisconsin DockDogs**



The club challenge takes place at the Cabela's National DockDogs® Championship. There is no additional registration fee required to participate in the Club Challenge at the National Championships, as the best jumps from each individual team will be used to calculate club scores. The winning club receives the perpetual trophy cup and complimentary affiliation fees for 2009.

**General Guidelines:**

- Each handler may represent only one club.
- All teams must have been a member of the club for at least one (1) month prior to the National Championships (September 16, 2009).
- Each club must turn in a roster to the Director of Club Affiliates one (1) week prior to the National Championships (October 11). Please send to [christen@dockdogs.com](mailto:christen@dockdogs.com).

**Earning Points - Performance:**

- Points will be awarded for the following placements within each wave:
  - 1st Place = 10 points;
  - 2nd Place = 8 points;
  - 3rd Place = 5 points;
  - 4th Place = 3 points.
- Points will be awarded for non-placement participation:
  - One point for each team that participates in competition and does not secure a 1st through 4th place finish in each wave.
  - Two points per wave will be awarded for each young handler, veteran dog, and lap dog that participates.
  - One time bonus points awarded for the following: Novice = 6 points; Junior = 5 points; Senior = 4 points; Master = 3 points; Elite = 2 points; Super Elite = 1 point; Lap Dog = 10 points; Veteran Dog = 10 points; Young Handler = 20 points.
- Points will be awarded for positive demonstration of team spirit:
  - Club Apparel: Points will be awarded for teams who choose to wear club apparel. One (1) point earned by the dog and one (1) point earned by the handler, for a maximum of two (2) points earned per wave.
  - Sportsmanship: Each club will submit ONE vote that represents the team vote on which club best represents good sportsmanship. Clubs cannot vote for themselves. The vote is worth 5 points.
  - Team Spirit: Each DockDogs National Staff member will submit ONE vote for the club that had the best team spirit. Each vote is worth 5 points.

- Club with most 4th place finishers.
- Club with most participants.
